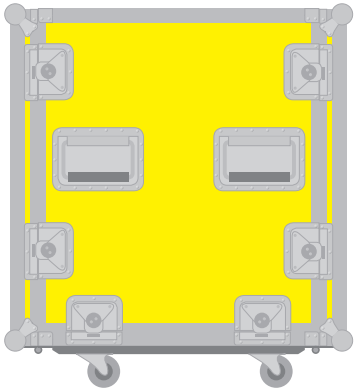


FOLD OUT BOX _ 0.1



Each flight case will include a custom built mixed media art installation, meaning all sorts of materials and objects. The inside lining of the case must be wood to enable the works to be fixed into the case and secured. The fold-out function that connects the bottom piece with two of the sides creates the surface the installation will be put on. The top side and the other two sides are not used when the works are on display and therefore we don't have many requirements regarding that part.

I have 2 concerns that might be better for the flight case builders/experts to deal with.

First is about where the bottom piece is connected with the sides. In these drawings it is done with simple hinges. The concern is that when one folds the case out, a gap appears between the sides and the bottom. I am not familiar with flight case solutions and would like to put it into the experts hands to find a suitable solution for this if possible

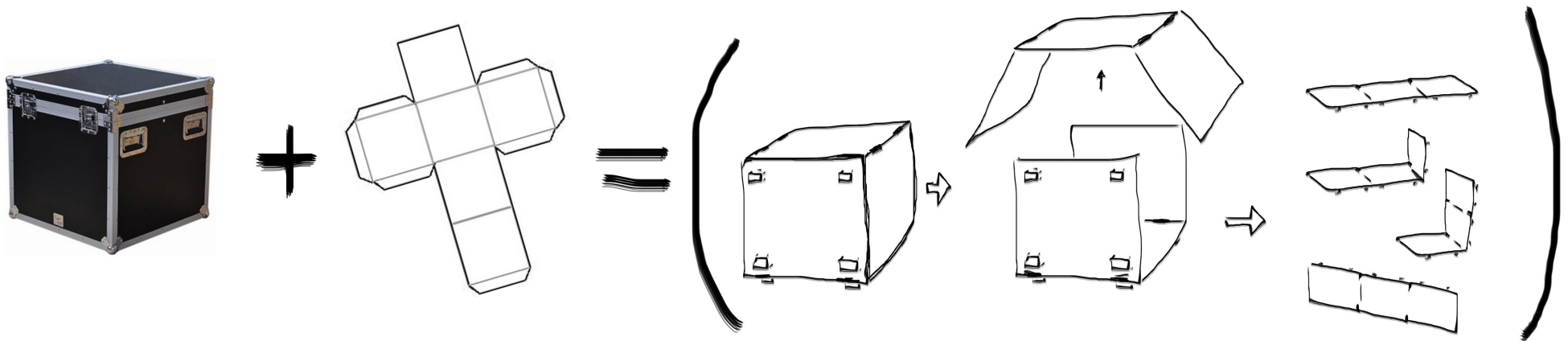
Second is about mounting. If it is possible to mount the exhibit part to a wall, we would like to keep that as an option.

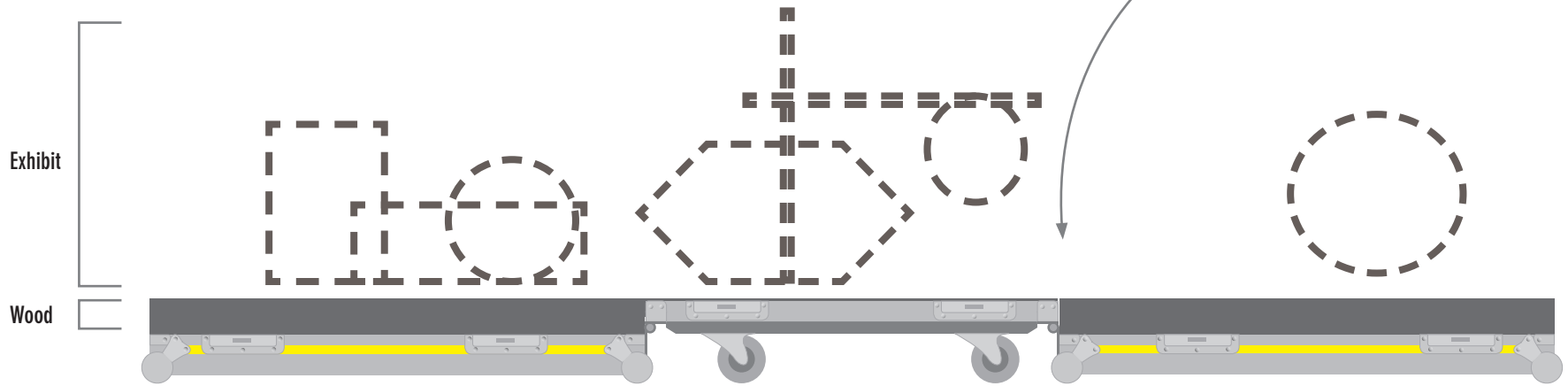
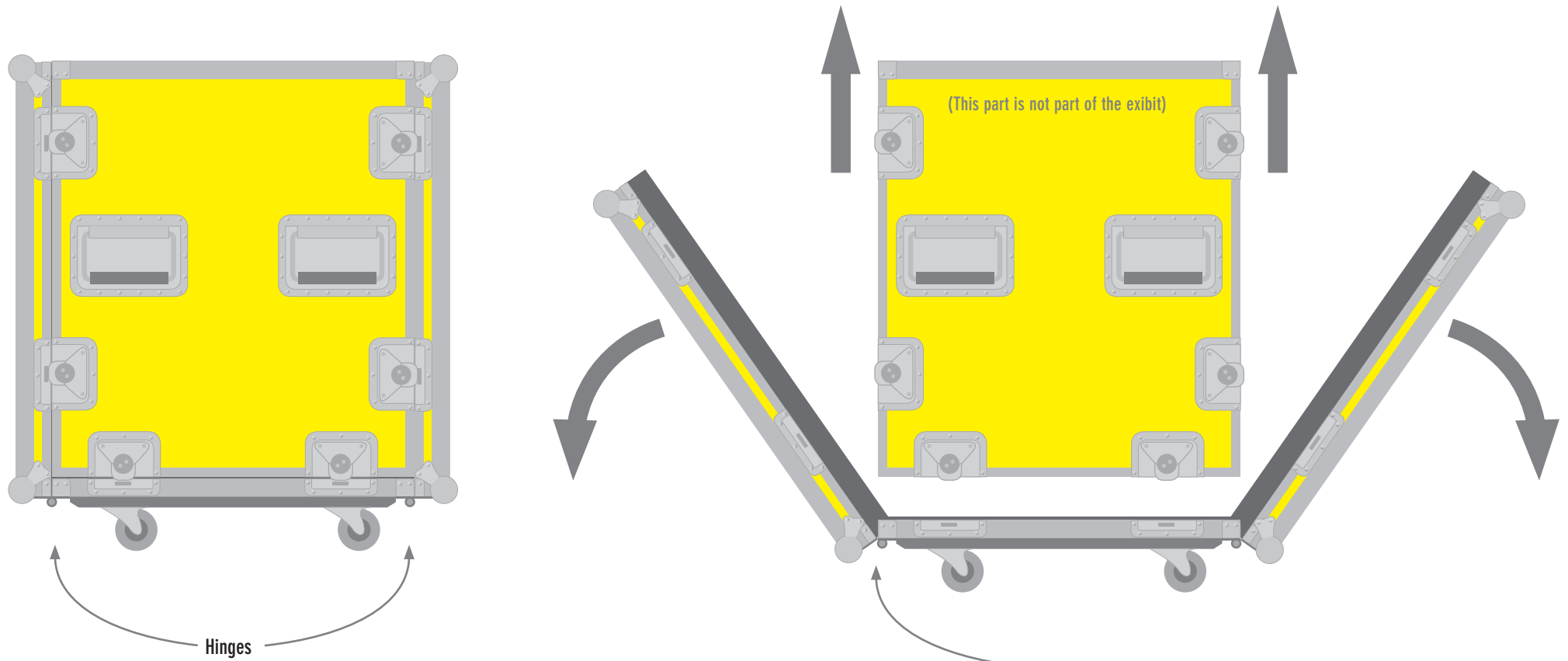

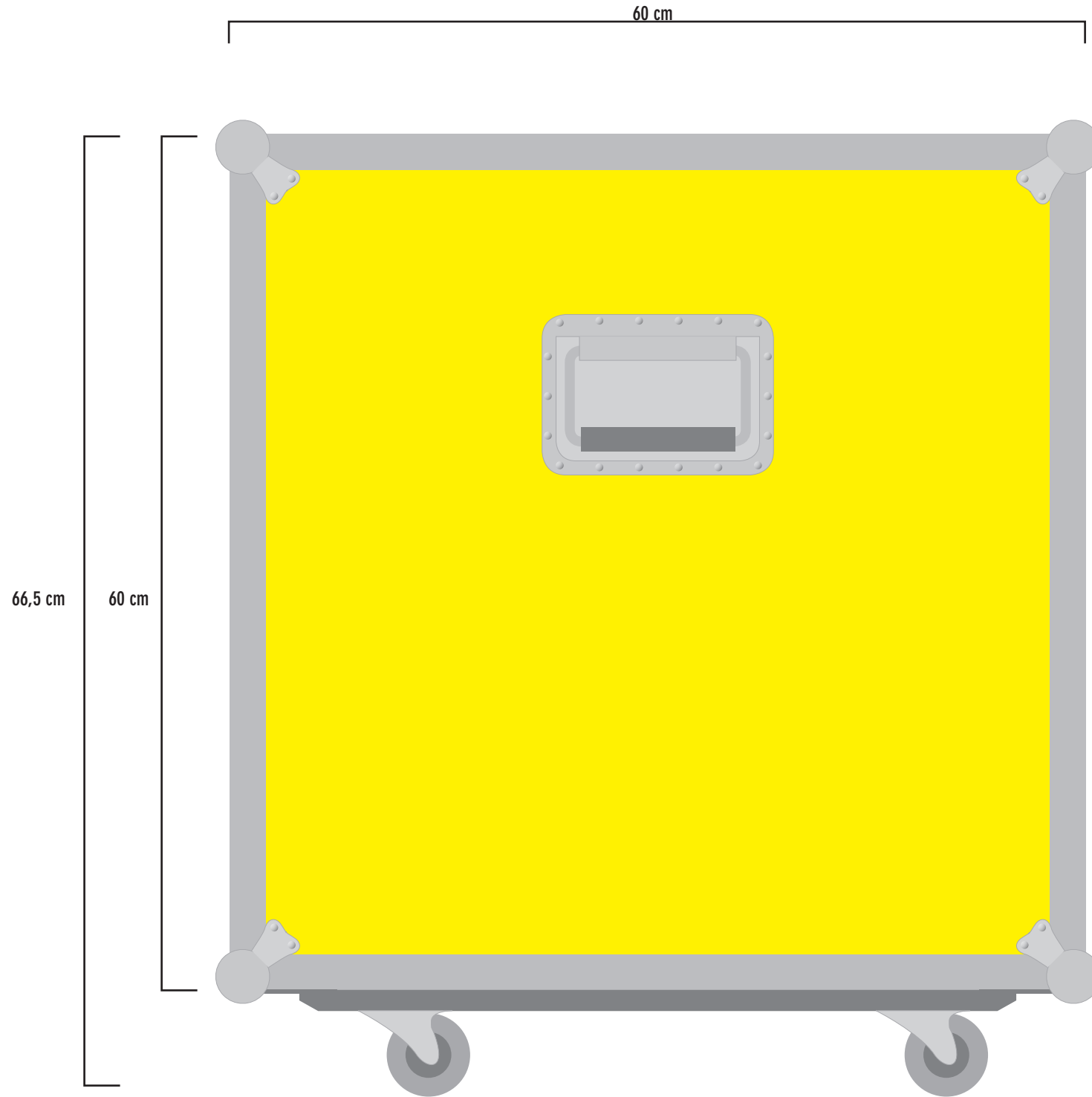




Front view
